

## Notification Note on COVID-19 Situational Update

The total laboratory tests conducted within 24 hours are 5274; of these one-hundred-twenty-nine (129) of them are confirmed positive for COVID-19 and the total confirmed cases as of today are 3759. Among the confirmed cases, 79 of them are male and 50 are female and their age ranges from 1 to 70 years old. All of the confirmed cases are Ethiopians. Among the cases, 85 of them are identified from Addis Ababa, 11 from Tigray region, 10 from Somali region, 7 from SNNP region, 6 from Amhara region, 5 from Oromia region, 4 from Diredawa City Administration and 1 from Afar region.

Among the total laboratory tests conducted, 18 (11 from health facility and 7 from community) of them were from samples collected from dead bodies none of which tested positive for COVID-19. Moreover, two people that were in treatment center have passed away. This brings the total death related to COVID-19 in our country to sixty-three (63). We would like to pass our condolences to the families. The details of the deaths are presented below.

**Since there is community transmission of COVID-19 all burials/funerals should be done with limited family members, observing all necessary precautions and avoiding mass gatherings. Let's all protect others by following all necessary measures!**

Furthermore, one-hundred-eleven (111) people (109 from Addis Ababa and 2 from Diredawa) recovered from the disease bringing the total number of recoveries to 849.
