
- Ethiopia is on ongoing cholera outbreak in **113 woredas** [Oromia (37), Ser(14), Cer(5), Sidama (15), Amhara (21), Afar (8), B.Gunuz(3), Dire Dawa(10), Harari(1)]. Among **113** active woredas (zero case report within **42 days**), 7 are actively reported in last 7 days, **43 woredas reporting zero case for 8-21 days** and **63** are reporting zero case for more than **21 days**.
- 115 cases were lately reported as of October 3, 2023. 25 cases newly seen at HFs and 21 cases in date of onset after previous reporting date, Sep 27, 2023
- Among cholera patients, 15-34 and 5-14 age groups accounted 42% and 19% respectively.
- Current inpatients in the CTC = 54
- From Amhara (4012 cases and 76 deaths by line list and phone text), non line listed additional 359 cases and deaths of 14 were reported in phone text.
- Since august 27, 2022, a total of **25,044** (**851** were in 2022) from **233** woredas have affected woredas (Oromia(93), Ser(30), Cer(19), Amhara(30), Sidama(23), D.Dawa(13), Somali(6), Afar(9), B.Gumuz(5), Harari(2). The difference of affected woredas from formers is due to cleaned data. The Index case was from Harana Buluk, August 27, 2022 & this outbreak was confirmed (4 from 5 were culture positive) on Sep 9, 2022. **Kumer refuge camp** reported 453 cases with 8 deaths and 279 cases from different IDP.
- The outbreak is controlled in 120 woredas in Oromia (56), Amhara(9), Somali (6), Ser(21), Cer(14), Sidama(8), Dire Dawa(3), BG(3) and Harari(1)(See the map), but they are at high risk due to being adjacent.

• Totally 192 CTCs have been established in regions having active outbreaks.

- OCV campaign started in 9 woredas, Amhara at September 16, 2023 and it is in good performance. Campaign launching was held at Sep 16 at Bahir Dar city and Bahir Dar Zuriya woreda. **1,810,792 (92.1%)** targeted pop were vaccinated in Day 1-7 campaign from 8 woredas. Among these vaccinated, **8,098** in Kumer refuge camp.
- *In four round of ICG support (6,145,278)*, 6,090,156 targeted population were vaccinated in **54** woredas of Somali, SNNP, Sidama, Oromia and **Amhara (ongoing)**
- Cholera unit PHEOC identified gaps on cholera outbreak preparedness in national PHEOC collaborative supportive supervision, May 23-24, 2023 with IM presence, Tigray.
- Third round cross-border/IGAD coordination meeting was conducted
- Current water supply coverage of cholera outbreak affected woredas in affected regions is low. Cumulative 124 water samples are tested by EPHI/UNICEF. Six EMWAT kits were installed on prioritized cholera affected woredas (WaSH cluster). Cholera outbreak affected woredas, zones, and regions are under strong follow up with strong active case searching, collaboration, distributing daily cholera SITREPs.




Epi-curve of cholera outbreak, Ethiopia, since January 1, 2023






Number of cholera affected kebele & cases (#)

Coordination for cholera outbreak intervention activities

- Joint mission (EPHI, WHO and UNICEF) to identify gaps on major public health emergencies (Cholera, Malaria, IDP, emergency nutrition, coordination, and joint action point
- Eight National Joint RRT (EPHI and AVOHC from WHO & ACDC) is deployed in 6 affected regions. For other regions, deployment is under facilitation.
- Operational cost and supply support concept note was submitted for CDC USA and USAID
- Coordination meeting (national TWG/week (51 times), regional TWG/week & Woreda TF/day)
- Third round cross-border/IGAD coordination meeting was conducted on synchronized OCV on Mandera triangle (Ethiopia, Kenya and Somalia)
- · Daily coordination meeting is ongoing (as report of woredas)
- · Daily line list reporting from Epi-centers
- · Alert letter is sent to neighboring regions
- Training is provided to 3485 HCWs in affeted regions
- Daily TF meeting with daily sharing of minutes (Kersadula)
- Cholera preparedness assessment was done in Tigray region
- Joint (EPHI & WHO) assessment was done and action points were forwarded to B. Gumuz and Oromia

PARTNERS SUPPORTING CHOLERA RESPONSE

WaSH Cholera outbreak intervention activities

- 885 latrines were built and utilization monitoring is done
- 35 water schemes maintenance
- 156 water schemes disinfection is done and ongoing
- 21 water points were established
- Six EMWAT kit is installed (5 in Oromia and 1 Somali)
- Water treatment chemicals were distributed
- Water trucking is done, and it is ongoing
- 63 water tanks were distributed
- 55,556 Jericans were supported

Surveillance for cholera outbreak intervention activities

- A RRTs are redeployed (EPHI, RHB, WHO, UNICEF, MSF-H, GOAL, IRC. SCI, Care, Islamic relief and Pastoralist concern)
- Case definitions are printed and distributed for HFs
- Ongoing active searching, contact tracing and disinfection & sensitization
- · RRT verified and investigated all reported alert and rumor in Oromia, Somali, SNNP & Sidama
- A total 1176 stool samples were collected and tested (90.1% positive for RDT and/ Culture). From 848 RDT tested, 772(91%) were RDT positive while among 328 culture tested, 288 (69.5%) were positive in all affected districts.

Case management for cholera outbreak intervention activities

- Totally 192 CTCs (will be updated to consider newly affected woredas) have been established in Oromia (73) & Somali (2), SNNP (75), Sidama/Hawassa (22) & Amhara (16), DD(2), Harari(1), B.Gumiz(1). ORPs at HFs are functional at all affected woredas. Among these CTCs, 10 CTCs are standard.
- All HPs and HFs of affected woredas established ORP
- Household disinfection being done in integration with contact tracing team
- Onsite capacity building being given by the deployed RRT
- Case management officers have been oriented on job by the deployed RRT
- Line list included nutritional variables
- MSF-H is supporting case management, standardizing CTC and train HCWs of case management

RCCE for cholera outbreak intervention activities

- Key messages of Cholera prevention disseminated in all districts affected by cholera through volunteers and health workers using megaphones reaching 41,800 people
- Islamic Affairs Supreme Council (IASC) are undertaking promotion
- Oromia region, Panel discussion was conducted by the regional health and water buraus
- School based sensitization is going
- Health education is providing at religious, community and HFs
- · Guideline, posters, job aids are delivered to HFs
- Social mobilization by Megaphones

Highlight on OCV campaign 2022 and 2023 for current cholera epidemics (Started in August 27/2022), Ethiopia

- 4th round of ICG support:1,917,913 OCV doses were supported from ICG for Amhara region outbreak response and pre-campaign is was performed in effective ways for Sep 16-23, 2023 scheduled campaign.
 1,810,792 (96.94%) targeted population were vaccinated for last 8 campaign days
- **3rd round of ICG support: 2,230,038** OCV dose campaign has cascaded in SNNP, Sidama, Oromia in August 10-17, 2023 with 99.4% coverage.
- 2nd round of ICG support: 1,910,416 were approved on March 30, 2023 and imported on April 11, 2023. Campaign started in targeted woredas on May 15, 2023 and vaccinated 1,909,407 (99%)
- 1st round of ICG support: ICG approved 86,910 among 2,000,466 requested dozes and imported on December 20, 2022. OCV campaign conducted to January 13-19, 2023 in Oromia while Somali (Dolo Ado & Bokollmayo woredas) was on Feb 22, 2023

- OCV campaign daily performance evaluation zoom meeting (National)
- Daily OCV campaign performance reporting
- Zonal & woreda leadership engagement
- Integration of other outbreak responses (active case searching, contact tracing, WaSH, RCCE, on job orientation)
- Daily updating and feedback
- Launching OCV campaign with MoH state minster, EPHI DG, regional health bureau, regional PHI DG



• Among 337 required CTCs, a total of 188 were dispatched



Major gaps & challenges cholera outbreak control

- Vehicle shortage affects response operation
- WaSH logistics

Prioritized next actions to control cholera outbreak

- Prepare high level cholera outbreak performance meeting (under the direction of higher officials)
- Following submitted requests for partners for their usual support
- Following deployed national joint RRT (EPHI, AVOHC, WHO, UNICEF) to control cholera outbreak in 28 days in all affected woredas and it is under facilitation.
- Strengthen WaSH-IPC activities (water quality monitoring, CTC standardization)
- Strengthen RCCE (Media spot, tele text for community)
- Following OCV requested for newly affected woredas in their respective region (Afar, B. Gumuz, Amhara, DD, South Ethiopia region)
- Conduct national review meeting on cholera outbreak response and control performance by inviting regional health bureau heads, water bureau heads, zonal health & water health department heads, regional/zonal/woreda PHEM coordinators in the presence EPHH DG and national relevant partners country directors
- Ensure participation of regional PHEM coordinators for national TWG meeting
- Strengthen active case searching and contact tracing of cholera cases
- Strengthen cross border collaboration with Kenya, Somalia, South Sudan and other
- Strengthen support for daily update from all health structures and provide evidence based feedback
- Strengthen national TWG meetings once a week on Tuesday from 11:00 am to 12:00 noon with sharing its minutes and cholera daily SITREP
